**Blue Island, IL:** For over 40 years, Blue Cap has been offering an array of services for infants, children, and adults with developmental disabilities throughout the metropolitan Chicago area. Last year over 380 families received support through Blue Cap. Programs include an Early Intervention, a School Program, an Integrated Day Care for children of all abilities, as well as a variety of job training and residential opportunities for adults.

On April 12, 2011, Blue Cap participated in the “Umbrellas for Peace” project. The children and adults supported by Blue Cap decorated Umbrellas with the world-famous artist Matt Lamb. Mr. Lamb’s *Umbrellas for Peace Project* is a global art project involving painting and decorating umbrellas.
